ORDER (1st allotment)

Out of total fund of Rs. 978.69 lakh (Rupees nine crore seventy eight lakh sixty nine thousand) only received from the Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal, Panchayat & RD Deptt. Vide No. 130(Sanction)-PN/P/II/1G-6/2005 dated 17-11-2005 as the 1st installment of the financial grant for the year 2005-06 to the PRI on recommendation of the 12th Finance Commission, an amount of Rs. 803.52 lakh (Rupees eight crore three lakh fifty two thousand) only is hereby sub-allotted to the Panchayat Samities and Gram Panchayats in this district as per the statement enclosed in Annexure-A and Annexure-B.

The charges in this respect are debitable to the head of account "2515-00-800-Other Expenditure-NP-NON PLAN-014-Assistance to Panchayati Raj Bodies, recommended by TwFC [PN]-V-31-Grants-in-aid-02-Other Grants" under demand No. 40 during the financial year 2005-06.

The Block Dev. Officers are hereby declared as Drawing & Disbursing Officer in respect of fund sanctioned in Annexure-A & Annexure-B. Grant of the Panchayat Samiti shall be transferred to its Local Fund Account. Block Dev. Officers shall report the TV No. and date under which the the fund will be drawn to this end for onward transmission.

The grant under the recommendation of the 12th Finance Commission is meant for taking care of maintenance of assets of the respective Panchayat Bodies, particularly those assets which are related to various civic services to the citizens of rural areas. Keeping in mind the priority areas mentioned in GO of the Deptt. of P&RD vide No. 4808/PN/O/I/4F-1/05 dated 29-07-05, the PRIs shall draw up plan for maintenance and up-gradation of existing assets owned by them (viz roads and bridges, buildings, markets, ferry ghats etc.), maintenance and up-gradation of facilities for better delivery of civic services (viz those related to public health, elementary education particularly physical infrastructure of the SSK/MSKs, nutrition including physical infrastructure of the Anganwadi Centers, drinking water sources, sanitation facilities including community toilets, drainage, solid water management etc.) and other services rendered by the Panchayats or activities assigned to those bodies vide this Govt. order No. 61-2/PN/O/V/4P-1/05 dated 07-11-05 for economic development and social justice.

In improving the quality and coverage of the services mentioned in the foregoing paragraph, by using the fund, the PRIs may incur expenditure of recurring nature for a definite time period (for example, supply of supplementary nutrients to severely malnourished children, extending medical services in remote health sub-centres etc.), but shall not pay any salary or fee or create or contract any permanent liability of any sort.

20% of the total entitlement of all the PRIs is also being allotted as shown in Annexure-B as Incentive Grants of the respective PRIs, calculated on the principles of average of per capita revenue collection, as enunciated in the earlier GO of the Deptt. of P&RD vide No. 4808/PN/O/I/4F-1/05 dated 29-07-05. The Block Dev. Officers being the DDO, shall draw and disburse this portion of the allotment as Incentive Grant to the PS & GP, only after ensuring that at least the draft Bye-Law of the PS & GP have duly been published by such bodies. Schemes taken up with the portion of the allotment shall form part of the Annual Action Plan which should be suitably supplemented for the purpose and prior approval from the authority, shall be obtained.

In partial modification of the principles of fund release, as mentioned in the earlier GO of the Deptt. of P&RD vide No. 4808/PN/O/I/4F-1/05 dated 29-07-05, 10% of the respective entitlements of the PRIs, meant for subsequent release against specific proposals for improvement of database, maintenance of accounts with the help of computers and for solid waste management, is now being released herewith. The PRIs may take up such schemes, as aforesaid, as part of their Annual Action Plan, which should be suitably supplemented for the purpose and prior approval of the authority, prescribed hereinafter, shall be obtained.

Panchayat Samiti shall take prior concurrence of the Zilla Parishad and the Gram Panchayats shall take prior concurrence of the Panchayat Samiti in respect of their Annual Action Plans for the entire period.

The District level / Sub-Divisional level Technical Support Team formed by the Zilla Parishad shall render assistance to the PRIs in formulation of schemes and the Annual Action Plan.

Allotment of fund is no authority to incur any expenditure unless the same is covered by sanction of the appropriate rules/authority. No expenditure should be made in excess of this allotment. The order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. vide Group- 'N' UO No. 1800 dated 31-10-2005.
